### "Learn by Doing" The Cal Poly Tradition

California Polytechnic State University has a strong tradition in agriculture and western heritage. The university was established in 1901 when California Governor Henry T. Gage signed the California Polytechnic School Bill.

Founded as a vocational secondary school, the campus was built adjacent to San Luis Obispo and held its first class on September 30, 1903. The first incoming class consisted of 20 students. In 1904, the school was coeducational with 40 new males students, and 12 new female students. Beginning in 1930, females were banned from the university until 1956.

In 1933, Cal Poly became a two-year technical and vocational school, and in 1940 began to offer bachelor degrees. Twenty-seven years later, the college was authorized to offer master degrees. From 1967 to 1970, the school's curriculum was reorganized into different units such as the School of Science and Math, School of Agriculture and Natural Resources, and the School of Architecture.

With the university's "learn by doing" philosophy, the university has had steady enrollment growth and construction of many significant buildings on the campus.

The goal of Champions Weekend is to raise money to make sure that the Cal Poly Rodeo team and rodeo competitors have a program and facility they can be proud of. Our efforts not only provide scholarships for our student athletes, but are also used for capital improvements such as desperately needed upgrades to the rodeo arena and horse boarding facilities at Cal Poly.
